

**AMENDMENT IN THE NATURE OF A SUBSTITUTE  
TO H. RES. 404  
OFFERED BY MR. THOMPSON OF MISSISSIPPI**

Strike all after the resolving clause and insert the  
following:

1 That the Secretary of Homeland Security is directed to  
2 transmit to the House of Representatives, not later than  
3 14 days after the date of the adoption of this resolution,  
4 copies of all documents relating to the Department of  
5 Homeland Security Office of Intelligence and Analysis In-  
6 telligence Assessment titled, “Rightwing Extremism: Cur-  
7 rent Economic and Political Climate Fueling Resurgence  
8 in Radicalization and Recruitment”, including—

9       (1) all source materials used in the drafting of  
10       that Intelligence Assessment;

11       (2) written material reflecting when the re-  
12       search and writing of that Intelligence Assessment  
13       began;

14       (3) a written description of the clearance proc-  
15       ess for that Intelligence Assessment and all other  
16       Office of Intelligence and Analysis-generated prod-  
17       ucts that were produced for and disseminated to

1 State, local, and tribal law enforcement agencies  
2 prior to April 20, 2009;

3 (4) any written opinions or guidance produced  
4 by the Department of Homeland Security Office for  
5 Civil Rights and Civil Liberties for the Office of In-  
6 telligence and Analysis on production and dissemina-  
7 tion of assessments to State, local, and tribal law en-  
8 forcement prior to April 20, 2009;

9 (5) any written opinions or guidance, produced  
10 by the Department of Homeland Security Chief Pri-  
11 vacy Officer for the Office of Intelligence and Anal-  
12 ysis, on production and dissemination of assessments  
13 to State, local, and tribal law enforcement prior to  
14 April 20, 2009;

15 (6) a written description of the clearance proc-  
16 ess for that Intelligence Assessment and all other  
17 Office of Intelligence and Analysis-generated prod-  
18 ucts ~~████████~~ produced for and disseminated to  
19 State, local, and tribal law enforcement agencies  
20 since April 20, 2009;

21 (7) a written description of what role, if any,  
22 the Chief Officer for Civil Rights and Civil Liberties  
23 of the Department of Homeland Security has played  
24 in the clearance process for Office of Intelligence  
25 and Analysis-generated products ~~████████~~ produced

1 for and disseminated to State, local, and tribal law  
2 enforcement since April 20, 2009;

3 (8) a written description of what role, if any,  
4 the Department of Homeland Security Chief Privacy  
5 Officer has served in the clearance process for Office  
6 of Intelligence and Analysis-generated products [REDACTED]  
7 [REDACTED] produced for and disseminated to State, local,  
8 and tribal law enforcement agencies since April 20,  
9 2009;

10 (9) a written description of what role, if any,  
11 the Under Secretary for Intelligence and Analysis of  
12 the Department has played in the clearance process  
13 for Office of Intelligence and Analysis-generated in-  
14 telligence products [REDACTED] produced for and dis-  
15 seminated to State, local, and tribal law enforcement  
16 agencies since April 20, 2009;

17 (10) the schedule of dates, if any, Office of In-  
18 telligence and Analysis employees received or will re-  
19 ceive privacy and civil liberties training; and

20 (11) any other written information on the inter-  
21 nal controls on the clearance process for Office of  
22 Intelligence and Analysis-generated intelligence  
23 products that have been disseminated to State, local,  
24 and tribal law enforcement since April 20, 2009.

Amend the title so as to read: “Resolution directing the Secretary of Homeland Security to transmit to the House of Representatives, not later than 14 days after the date of adoption of this resolution, copies of documents relating to the Department of Homeland Security Office of Intelligence and Analysis Intelligence Assessment titled, ‘Rightwing Extremism: Current Economic and Political Climate Fueling Resurgence in Radicalization and Recruitment’.”.
