NOMINATION SELECTION PROCESS

Each Congressional office uses a selection process for academy nominations designed to fulfill its own criteria and standards. The various procedures can often become confusing to those who apply to more than one source. Misunderstandings and errors can be avoided by carefully reading the instructions of each office to which you apply for a nomination.

Congressman McCaul's academy nominations are handled by Destinee Vargas in the College Station office. Please feel free to contact Ms. Vargas at (979) 431-6480 or Destinee.Vargas@mail.house.gov should you have any questions or need assistance in completing the process.

<u>PLEASE NOTE:</u> By signing Congressman McCaul's application, you are acknowledging and accepting responsibility for the requirements set by this office. It is YOUR responsibility to submit all required application information by **Friday, September 19, 2025.**

Due to the competitiveness involved in receiving an academy nomination, you are encouraged to apply to every nominating authority available to you. You should apply to both U.S. Texas Senators, in addition to your Congressman. U.S. Senators nominate from an applicant pool based on the entire state and Congressmen nominate from applicants domiciled in their Congressional Districts. Applicants may apply to both of their U.S. Senators and their U.S. Congressman (only one nomination is necessary to receive an appointment). Applicants may also apply to the Vice President of the United States, who can nominate applicants from the country at large.

Candidates who apply to Congressman McCaul for a nomination will be considered based on merit, including evidence of character, motivation, scholarship, leadership, and physical aptitude. Candidates should also apply to other colleges or universities while working to secure his/her nomination and appointment at an academy. Not every applicant will receive a nomination, nor will every nominee be offered an appointment.

In addition, candidates should not limit themselves to only one academy, we recommend you apply to all the academies and decide which will be your 1st, 2nd, 3rd, and 4th choice. Each congressional office has a set number of nominations they can give to each academy.

To qualify for the final phase of the nomination process, applicants must complete their file by **Friday**, **September 19**, **2025**. **If applicants do not meet the deadline**, **they are NOT eligible for a nomination**.

Once nominees are selected by congressional offices, those nominations are submitted to the academies. Each academy will then make the final determination of who will be offered appointments.

Incomplete applications will not be considered for nomination. **SERVICE ACADEMY APPLICATION FORM** completed and signed by applicant. This must be typed. OFFICIAL COPY OF HIGH SCHOOL TRANSCRIPT with an embossed seal that includes courses currently in progress, GPA through junior year, and class rank. Should your school not rank students, you must have a counselor or principal denote this on your transcript. Your counselor MUST convert your score to a 4.0 scale. OFFICIAL COPY OF COLLEGE TRANSCRIPT (if applicable) including courses currently in progress and GPA. THREE (3) LETTERS OF RECOMMENDATION completed by teachers, counselors, religious leaders, coaches, employers or community leaders. Please do not have family members write the letters of recommendation on your behalf. It is your responsibility to ensure these letters of recommendation are submitted in a timely manner and included in your packet. NOTE: Recommendation forms from other offices will NOT be accepted in lieu of recommendation letters. All letters of recommendation must be postmarked by the **Friday**, **September 19**, **2025** deadline. OFFICIAL SAT/ACT SCORES sent directly from the college boards – No copies will be accepted. NOTE: Test scores must be postmarked by Friday, September 19, 2025. To be considered for a nomination, you must have taken the SAT/ACT prior in order to meet the September 19, 2025, deadline. Test scores may be updated after this date only if the student had already submitted scores by the deadline. Carefully consider the dates you are taking tests! My score report codes are: SAT-4439 / ACT-7691. Please note that there are minimum test scores that must be attained to even be considered for an appointment by a service academy. Check each service academy's website for its minimum requirements. PERSONAL STATEMENT: A typed (double-spaced), well-written 250 word essay (12-point Times New Roman font ONLY) detailing why you want to attend a U.S. Service Academy and why you want to be commissioned as an officer in the U.S. Armed Forces. Place full name on essay. Please use NORMAL margins for this essay. **TYPED RESUME** describing your involvement in athletics, school activities, the community, or other activities you consider important, as well as all awards and honors. _CURRENT COLOR PHOTOGRAPH (wallet size) with your name, hometown, written on back. NO STAPLES: If you are not submitting your application digitally, please do not staple your document. **NOTE:** Applications that fail to follow instructions will not be accepted.
