
I am requesting funding for the City of Bryan Aquifer Storage and Recovery Program in fiscal year 2027. The entity to receive funding for this project is City of Bryan, located at 300 South Texas Avenue, Bryan, TX, 77803, United States.

The purpose of this request is to advance construction of aquifer storage and recovery infrastructure in Bryan, Texas, including two aquifer storage and recovery wells, a pump station, and associated piping needed to store water underground for future use during drought and high-demand periods. The project is an appropriate use of taxpayer funds because it invests in durable water infrastructure that improves drought preparedness, reduces future supply risk, and supports continued economic growth in Bryan and Brazos County.

The project has a federal nexus because the funding provided is for purpose authorized by Section 1452 of the Safe Drinking Water Act, 42 U.S.C. 300j-12
