
I am requesting funding for College Heights Utility Rehabilitation in fiscal year 2026. The entity to receive funding for this project is the City of College Station located at P.O. Box 9960, College Station, Texas, 77842, United States.

The purpose of this request is to replace aging water and wastewater lines in the College Heights neighborhood of College Station, originally built in the 1940s when the city's population was under 2,200. The area now supports over 2,700 residents and sits adjacent to Texas A&M University, where demand for redevelopment is high. This project is an appropriate use of taxpayer funds because addresses critical infrastructure needs in College Station, Texas. This project is crucial for reducing service disruptions and meeting the demand for growth in one of the city's oldest and fastest-growing areas.

The project has a federal nexus because the funding provided is for purposed authorized by Section 1452 of the Safe Drinking Water Act, 42 U.S.C. 300j-12.
