Dear Chairman Cole and Ranking Member DeLauro:


I am requesting funding for the Bryan Avenue Revitalization in Historic Downtown Bryan in fiscal year 2027. The entity to receive funding for this project is City of Bryan, located at 300 South Texas Avenue, Bryan Texas, 77803, United States.

The purpose of this request is to continue the progression of infrastructure rehabilitation as identified in the Downtown Masterplan. Streetscape and landscaping will be like that in the previously completed phases of capital improvements including brick paver insets and historic streetlights. All overhead utilities will be replaced with underground facilities. Also included in the project is the replacement of water, sewer, and storm sewer utilities. All phases of the project are estimated to cost over \$20,000,000 far exceeding the \$5 Million in Community Project Funding.

The project has a federal nexus because the funding provided is for the purpose authorized in 42 U.S.C. 5305(a)(2)
